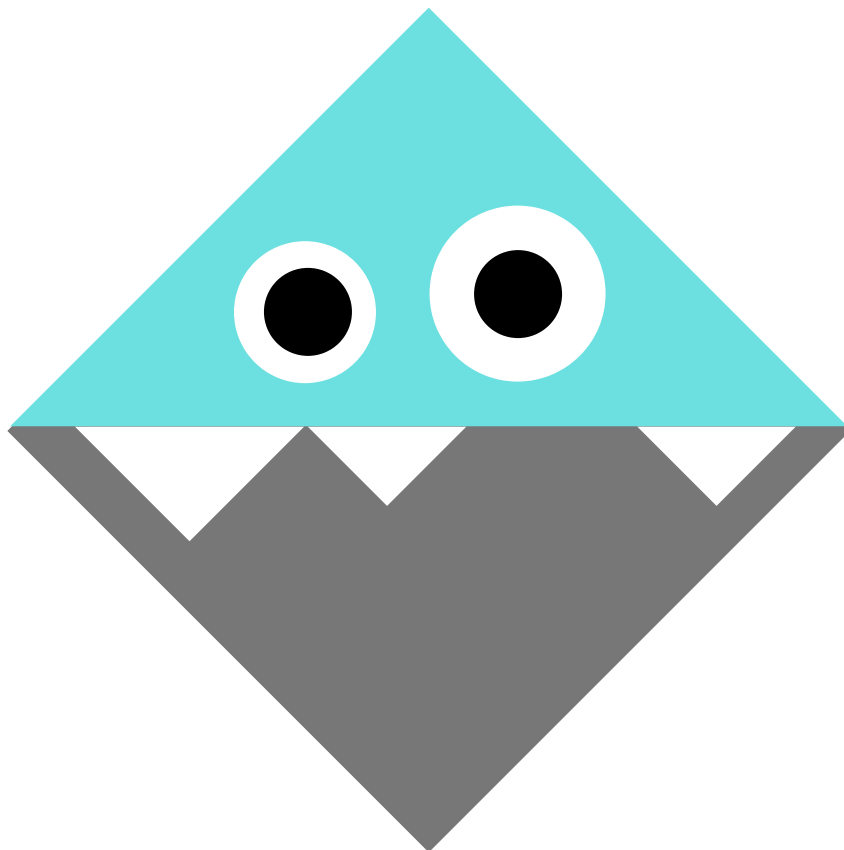


Corner Bookmark Craft Inspired by

# Instructions

## You'll Need

- colored/patterned cardstock
- scissors
- glue stick
- googly eyes
- crayons or markers
- craft supplies for decorating (opt.)



# Step 1

Trace this template onto your colored paper.  
Cut it out.  
Cut off the edges shown below in red.



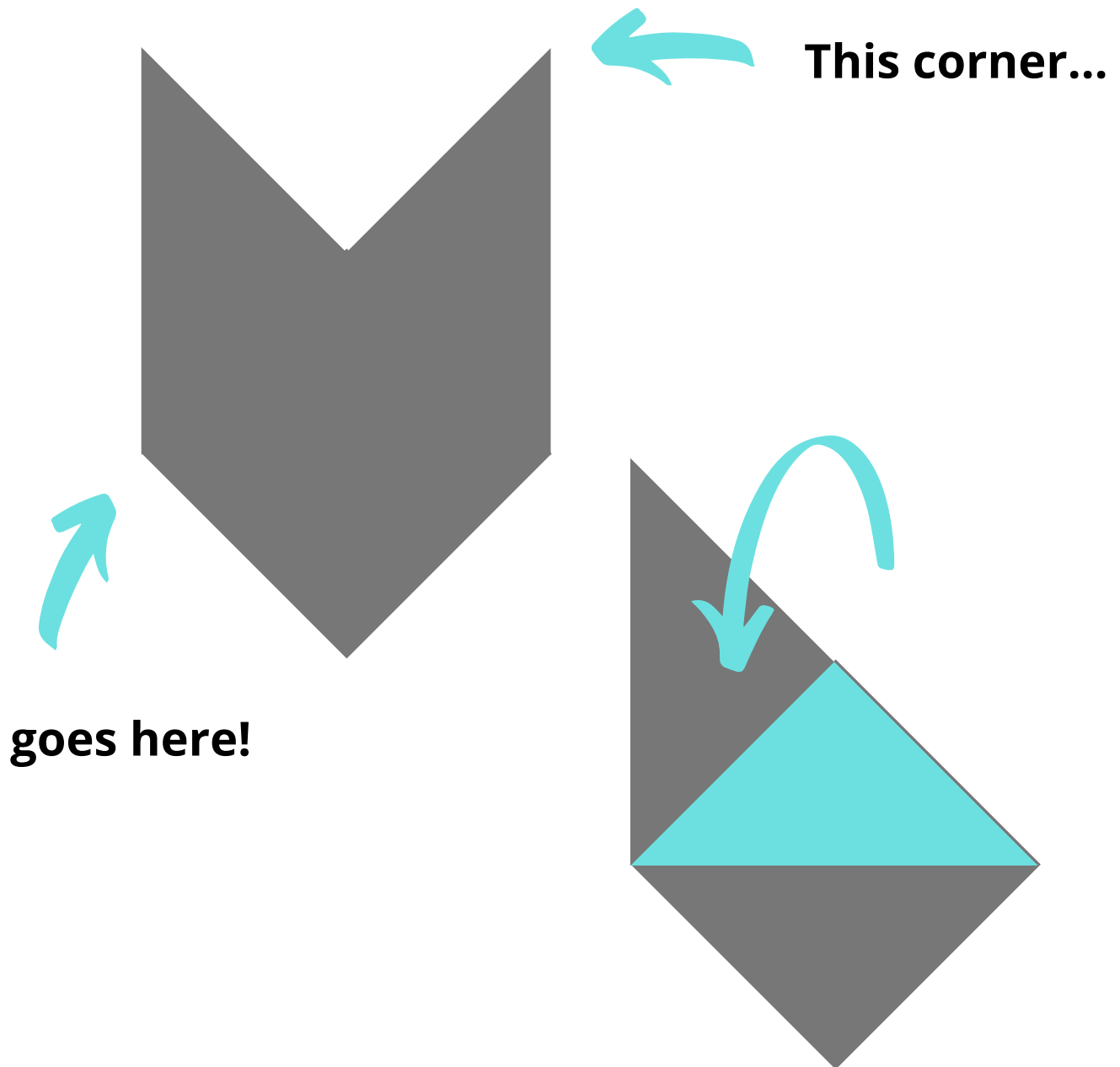
## Step 2

Turn your bookmark so that the side with two points is on the top—like it has ears!



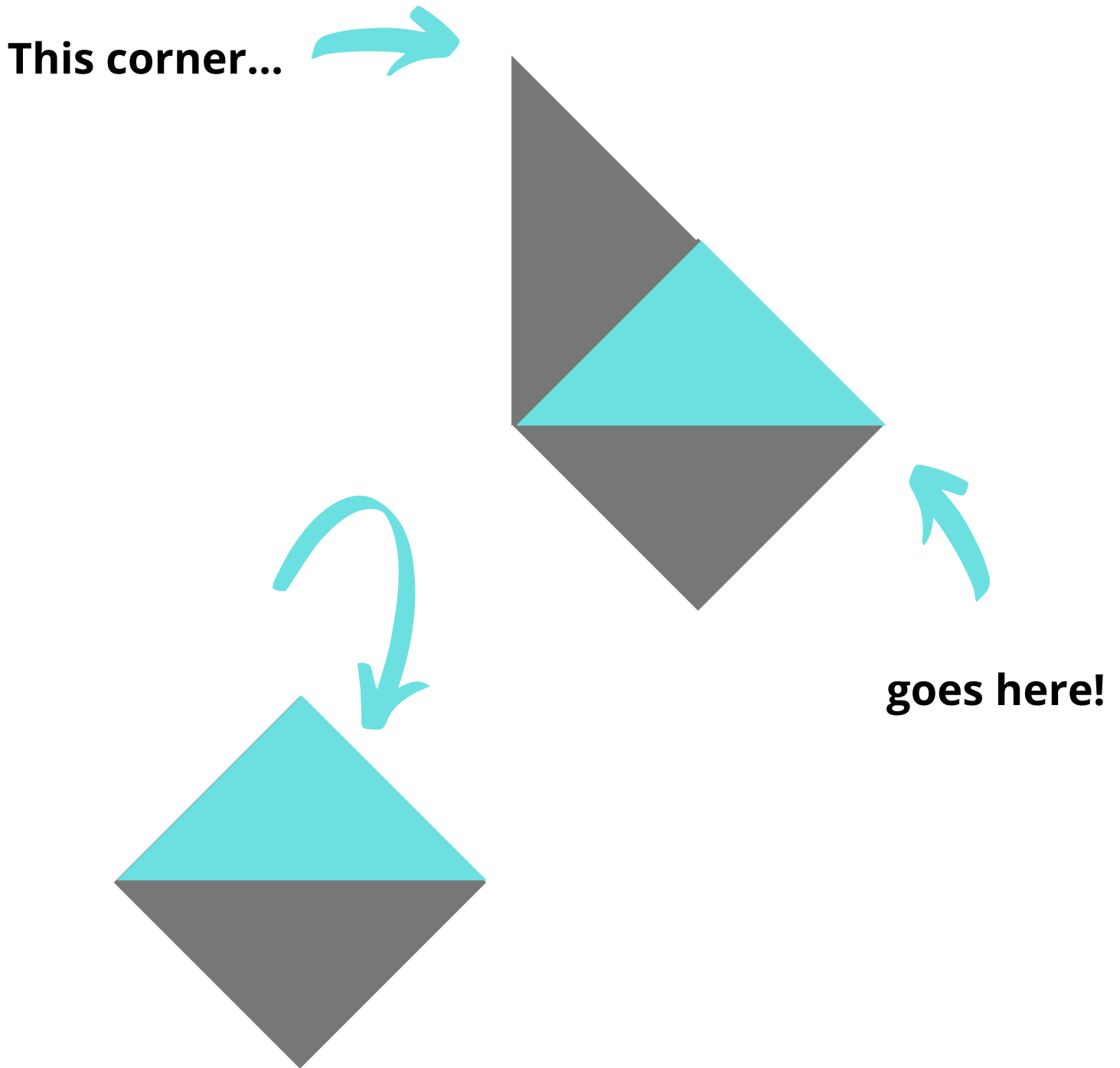
## Step 3

Fold each of the ears so that the top corner touches the middle left corner.



# Step 4

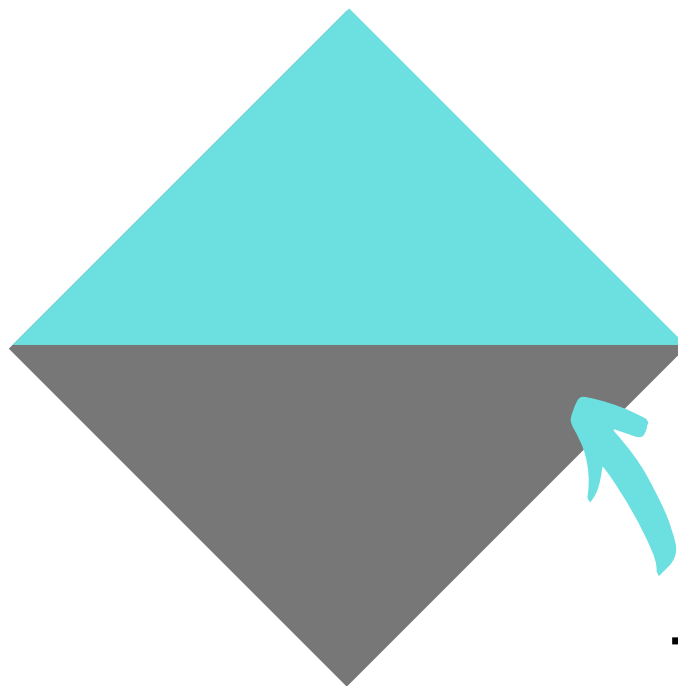
Repeat with the remaining top corner



## Step 5

Now you should have a square where the top two pieces are folded over one another, leaving a gap underneath between the folded pieces and the back of the paper.

Glue the folded edges to each other **but not the back!** *The gap is where the corner of your book's page will go.*



## Step 6

Time to decorate your monster bookmark!
